Guatemala eliminates COVID-19 vaccination and testing requirements for inbound travelers

Executive summary

Inbound travelers to Guatemala are no longer required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or get tested for COVID-19 prior to entry or after arrival in the country.

Key issues

The new rules went into effect on 13 August 2022. Notwithstanding, inbound travelers who test positive for COVID-19 after entering Guatemala may be required to isolate at a government-approved location.

Impact on employers

The elimination of COVID-19 vaccination and testing requirements is expected to reduce costs for organizations that deploy their employees to Guatemala, and facilitate and expedite the entry of Guatemalan citizens, residents and international business travelers into the country.
