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Canada's Global Minimum Tax Act released for public comment

On 4 August 2023, the Department of Finance released for public comment several packages of draft legislative proposals, including new draft legislative proposals relating to the implementation of a global minimum tax under OECD BEPS 2.0 Pillar Two. More specifically, the draft *Global Minimum Tax Act* is intended to implement the income inclusion rule, the domestic minimum topup tax rules and the UTPR (sometimes referred to as the Undertaxed Profits Rule) that form part of the Model Rules for the Global Minimum Tax (GloBE Rules) that were released by the OECD on 20 December 2021.

Brazil's visa requirement for nationals of Australia, Canada and the United States postponed to January 2024

Effective 10. January 2024, Australian Canadian and US nationals will be required to obtain a visa prior to enterin

Effective 10 January 2024, Australian, Canadian and US nationals will be required to obtain a visa prior to entering Brazil for business, tourism and other purposes. The new visa requirement was previously scheduled to go into effect on 1 October 2023. Impacted individuals will be able to file visa applications online starting in early/mid-December 2023.
